5. Closing date: **30. 6. 2018** 

6. Limit: max. 2 entries in each section by participant (including joint compositions)

8. Annoncement of results: **28. 10. 2018** –100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of Czechoslovakia

9. Claims: not allowed, announced results and tourney director's decisions will be final

10. Prize fund: a) 250 EUR, chess books, diplomas

4 financial prizes: 100 EUR - winner, 3 x 50 EUR -  $2^{nd}$  prize,  $3^{rd}$  prize and the

most difficult problem for solving b) 6.250 Kč, chess books, diplomas

4 financial prizes: 2.500~Kč - winner, 3~x~1.250~Kč -  $2^{\text{nd}}$  prize,  $3^{\text{rd}}$  prize and the

most difficult problem for solving c) 99 EUR, chess books, diplomas

3 financial prizes: 33 EUR

Tourney director has the right to change tournament propositions.

A solving tourney will take place before announcement of results, that would determine the most difficult compositions in sections a) and b).
