
Out of the ten compositions received for this tourney, seven have been kept in the award. A major consideration of value was the number of moves being parts of echoes, white as well as black.





First Prize : Alexandre Semenenko (H10)

White echo on all three moves with self-pins, one black echo on selfblocks, and a Zilahi. A rich problem.

Second Prize : Vitaly Medintsev (H2)

A full number of thematic echoes (three white and two black ones) with a Zilahi play. But less mysterious than the first prize.



Complete black and white thematic echoes. Zilahi and white battery-play in model mates.







First Honourable Mention : Jorge Kapros & Jorge Lois (H9)

Again complete thematic echoes with Umnov on white halfpin.

Model mates, but no Zilahi.

Second Honourable Mention : Menachem Witztum (H8)

White self-pins, soon unpinned, and black underpromotions in dual-avoidance. Model mates again.

Third Honourable Mention : Pierre Tritten (H1)

White echoes on three moves, including switchbacks. No thematic black echo, but dual-avoidance $\text{N}-\text{Q}$ on e3.

- 1... $\text{Q} \times d3$ 2. $\text{Q} e3 \text{ Q} f5$ 3. $\text{Q} e4 \text{ Q} g4\#$

Commendation : Ladislav Packa (H3)

The white thematic echo is light, and there is no black one. The black play is pleasing with its vertically reversed mode.
